After its win over Iowa at the Knapp Center this past Sunday, the Drake University women's basketball team is set to open the 2016 Tulane Classic against Auburn on Wednesday, Dec. 21 in New Orleans. Tipoff is scheduled for 3 p.m. with the neutral site contest broadcast on the radio via 1350 ESPN Des Moines.

Drake defeated Iowa, 81-76, in front of a crowd of 3,307 fans on a bone-chilling cold day in Des Moines. The fans who braved the elements witnessed Drake snap a 14-game losing streak in the in-state series with Iowa. Prior to Sunday, the Bulldogs' last victory over the Hawkeyes was Nov. 25, 2001 in a 75-72 decision that went to overtime in Iowa City.

Four Bulldogs, led by senior Caitlin Ingle with a team-high 20 points, finished in double figures in this year's victory. Senior Lizzy Wendell added 15 points while freshman Becca Hittner recorded her first career double-double with 14 points and a career-best 10 rebounds. Redshirt sophomore Becca Jonas rounded out the group with 12 points and added five rebounds and two steals.

Ingle's scoring performance matched her season-high in a game this year (Creighton), and she handed out seven assists and snagged three rebounds. She and Hittner were recognized by the Missouri Valley Conference for their outstanding performances on Monday as they were the named the MVC Player and Newcomer of the Week, respectively. The honors are the first in each player's career.

Auburn travels to New Orleans coming off a 92-87 defeat to No. 23/24 Virginia Tech Sunday evening. The Tigers' three losses have been by a combined 14 points. Seniors Brandy Montgomery and Katie Frerking average 16.2 and 15.7 points per game while Frerking leads the team in rebounding at 8.1 per game. Auburn advanced to the second round of the 2016 NCAA Tournament.

Drake and Auburn have met just once and it was all the way back on Jan. 4, 1981 in a tournament hosted by Miami University that the Tigers eked out a 77-76 win.

Following Wednesday's game, Drake will play either the tournament hosts, Tulane, or Eastern Washington on Thursday.

National Leaders

Caitlin Ingle averages 8.4 assists per game, which ranks second in the nation while Lizzy Wendell's scoring average of 21.2 is ninth. Sammie Bachrodt is shooting a blistering 50.0 percent from behind the three-point line to lead the MVC and rank 11th in the country.

As a team, Drake is third in the nation in assists at 21.1 per game and sixth in free-throw percentage at 79.9. The Bulldogs' field goal percentage of 47.6 and scoring average of 81.3 ranks 15th and 22nd, respectively.

Two Is Better Than One

The duo of Becca Hittner and Becca Jonas were instrumental in Drake's win over Iowa. The pair, who both missed games at the start of the season due to injury, each played outstanding. Hittner recorded her first career-double with 14 points and a career-best 10 rebounds. She added three assists, one steal and made two key three-pointers and 6-of-6 from the free throw line in a career-high 25 minutes. Jonas matched a season high with 12 points and added five rebounds and two steals in 28 minutes.

Welcome To An Exclusive Club

Wendell joined an exclusive Drake and MVC group this season. Wendell eclipsed the 2,000-point mark with 18 points in the win at Nebraska. She is just the fourth Bulldog and seventh MVC player to score 2,000 or more points. Wendell is the first Drake player since Wanda Ford (1982-86) to accomplish the impressive scoring feat. She has scored 10 or more points in 86-straight games and scored 2,035 career points in 104 games for a career scoring clip of 19.6 points per game.

More Milestones

Ingle accomplished a pair of career milestones this year. In the Iowa State, she surpassed 1,000 career points and in the Clarke game moved past 600 career assists.

Coaching Milestone

Drake head coach Jennie Baranczyk earned her 75th career win in the road victory at Nebraska. Baranczyk started her head coaching career at Drake in 2012, and is in her fifth season at the helm of the program.

Scoring, Scoring, Scoring

Drake tallied 118 points in the win over Clarke in the program's annual "Pack The Knapp For Character Kids Game". The 118 points are the second most ever in Drake history and the third most in MVC history. Drake made 48-of-78 shots and handed out 34 assists in the win.

Down Goes Big Red

Drake earned an 84-70 win at Nebraska on Dec. 6. The Bulldogs rallied from a 33-32 halftime deficit to take down the Cornhuskers for

their first win in the series since 2002. The road game at Nebraska is the first of three games for the Bulldogs against Power 5 schools this month.

Previewing the Bulldogs

Drake head coach **Jennie Baranczyk** enters her fifth season with nine returning players plus three freshmen for the 2016-17 season. The Bulldogs are coming off a 23-10 season a year ago as the team recorded its second-straight 20+plus win season, a feat that hadn't been done since 2000-01 and 2001-02. Drake qualified for postseason play for the second-consecutive season, advancing to the second round of the WNIT. The 23 wins were the most for the program since the 2007-08 season.

Senior forward **Lizzy Wendell** is set for her final season as a Bulldog with a chance to join an impressive group of former Drake and Missouri Valley Conference greats. Wendell, who led the league in scoring in each of the previous two seasons, is a three-time All-MVC First Team selection and was named the MVC Freshman of the Year in 2014. She has scored 2,050 career points to rank fifth among active NCAA players and at Drake and seventh all-time in the MVC. The Blue Springs, Mo., native has an opportunity to move to No. 2 all-time in career points at Drake and in the MVC with former Drake legend Wanda Ford (1982-86) currently second all-time in school and MVC history with 2,636 points. She has scored 10 or more points in 87-straight games, a streak that goes all the way back to her freshman season.

Senior point guard **Caitlin Ingle** is also set for her final season as a Bulldog. The local product from Runnells, Iowa, has dished out 610 career assists to rank second all-time at Drake, third among active players and fourth all-time in the MVC. Ingle can pass former Drake standout Connie Newlin (1978-82), who had 767 career assists, for the top mark in program history. She can pass Melanie Boeglin, who played at Indiana State from 2002-06 and had 685 assists, for the top mark in league history. Ingle surpassed the 1,000-point mark in her career in the game at Iowa State on Nov. 20.

Senior **Cortni Rush** and juniors **Maddy Dean** and **Paige Greiner** return for their third seasons. Rush, who transferred to Drake as a sophomore from North Iowa Area Community College, played in 52 games her first two seasons. Dean led the team in rebounding at 7.0 per game while scoring 12.9 points per game as a sophomore. Last season, Greiner played in all 33 games and paced the team in three-point shooting at 43.0 percent.

Sophomore **Sara Rhine** had a breakout debut season being named the MVC Freshman of the Year and the MVC Sixth Player of the Year. Rhine averaged 13.3 points per game behind 62.9 percent field goal shooting, which ranked third in the nation. Fellow sophomores **Sammie Bachrodt** and **Nicole Miller** also contributed significantly in their first seasons. Bachrodt started all 33 games and was named to the MVC All-Freshman team while Miller played in every game and averaged 6.4 points per game. The Bulldogs also welcome back redshirt sophomore Becca Jonas, who missed all of last season due to injury. In her first season (2014-15), Jonas averaged 12.5 points per game and led the team in rebounding at 9.1 per game on her way to all-conference honorable mention honors and she was named to the MVC All-Freshman team.

Drake has three freshmen on this season's roster in **Becca Hittner**, **Mya Mertz** and **Brenni Rose** who will compete for playing time in their first seasons. Hittner is a local product from Dowling Catholic while Mertz and Rose hail from the Kansas City metro area.

Former University of Iowa standout and Des Moines native, **Jennie (Lillis) Baranczyk** (pronounced bah-rah-n-check), was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Drake University in April, 2012.

The 2015-16 season was Baranczyk's fourth season at the helm as the team went 23-10 to record their second consecutive 20-win season, all with just one senior on the roster in Emma Donahue and without Becca Jonas who missed the season due to injury. It is the first time Drake has recorded 20-plus wins in two straight seasons since 2000-01 and 2001-02 seasons. The team went to the WNIT and earned a first round win over Sacred Heart for the program's first postseason win since 2008.

Drake racked up another impressive set of individual awards and honors, led by freshman Sara Rhine, who had a banner first season as a Bulldog capped by winning the MVC Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year awards as well as collecting All-MVC honorable mention honors and being picked to the All-MVC Freshman team. Rhine is the third straight Bulldog to win the MVC Freshman of the Year award. Juniors Caitlin Ingle and Lizzy Wendell each were each selected to the All-MVC First Team for the second straight year. Wendell is the first Bulldog in over 10 years to earn All-MVC First Team accolades three times. Joining Rhine on the All-MVC Freshman Team was Sammie Bachrodt who had a great first season. Donahue and Ingle along with sophomore Maddy Dean were recognized for stellar years on the court and in the classroom as they were each awarded All-MVC Scholar-Athlete honors. Donahue earned honorable mention accolades while Dean was named to the second team and Ingle was tabbed to the first team for the second straight year.

Baranczyk came to Drake after a two-year stint as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Colorado, where she was on the staff of head coach Linda Lappe, a former Drake assistant coach. Prior to Colorado, Baranczyk was an assistant coach for four seasons at Marquette after two seasons as an assistant coach at Kansas State. Baranczyk reached postseason tournament play every season as a player and assistant coach. She coached in two NCAA tournaments and won two WNIT championships (Kansas State (2006) and Marquette (2008) as an assistant coach. At Iowa, she played in three NCAA tournaments and one WNIT and helped Iowa win the 2001 Big Ten Tournament.

A three-time captain at Iowa, Baranczyk, was a four-year letterwinner at forward from 2000-04 under former Drake head coach Lisa Bluder. One of the best all-around players in Hawkeye basketball history, she was a three-time All-Big Ten Conference selection, earning first-team honors as a junior in 2003 and second-team honors as a sophomore in 2002 and as a senior in 2004. She was an honorable mention All-American in 2003.

She graduated as the only player in Iowa history in the top 10 of five major statistical categories: points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks, and is one of only two Hawkeye players to score more than 1,700 points and grab 800 rebounds.

Baranczyk graduated from Iowa in 2004 with her bachelor's degree in communication studies and from Kansas State with her master's degree in counseling and student development in 2007. At Iowa, she was the recipient of the 2004 Big Ten Conference's Medal of Honor. First awarded in 1914, the Big Ten's oldest award is given annually to a student in the graduating class of each university that demonstrated proficiency in scholarship and athletics. Baranczyk was also a three-time Academic All-Big Ten pick, a WBCA Scholarship Award recipient, CoSIDA Academic All-District honoree, and a Collegiate Basketball Award for Excellence semifinalist as a senior in 2004.

In her prep career, she helped Dowling Catholic in Des Moines win state championships in 1998 and 2000 and is a member of the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union Hall of Fame. Jennie and her husband, Scott, have a son, Eli, and a daughter, Jordi.
