Then my sophomore year I went 6-5 in my second meet and ruptured a blood vessel in my right thigh. I was finished for the year. Then this winter I hurt my right knee in basketball and had exploratory surgery on it. That's my take-off leg in the high jump, long jump and high hurdles. I might try the pole vault now. I went 10 feet last week."

John Schmidt, 4 x 1,600, anchor for Illinois in 3:59.0, 16:16.05 third place team. "I felt okay on the backstretch, and I wanted to start, but I didn't change gears quick enough. I had a step on Arkansas (O'Mara), but he wanted through there. I got bumped a little. I had a shot at winning because I'm a kicker. It was there for us."

Frank O'Mara, 4 x 1,600, anchor for Arkansas in 4:01.9, 16:14.00 to win. "I went to the same school as O'Shaughnessy. As a junior in high school I ran 3:53 for meters in Limerick, Ireland. It's a town of about 85,000. We knew we had a chance for a great time. We were apprehensive without Dave Taylor who has run 4:01 three times this year. I kn-w I could take it on the backstretch. I knew I wouldn't get boxed. I have this terrible feeling about being boxed. I still wasn't going very fast in the last 100 meters. I'm saving myself for tomorrow in the 1500.

Mark Muggleton, leadoff for Arkansas 4 x 1,600: "We all had at least another second faster time in us."

Jeff Nielsen, 100 meter dash high school boys final in 10.76, senior at Britt. "My best time was in Dayton, Ohio, last with a 10.70. Today was a good race. I feel good. It could be a bit hotter, but I won."

Patty Healey, junior from Dubuque, Wahlert, high school girls 100 meter dash, set a new Drake record, 12.33, previous record 12.36. "I thought it was pretty all the way. I could feel her (Leisa Davis) coming right after me. I thought it was awfully close, though the competition didn't scare me at all. I'll be back next year."

Pat Johnson, anchor of Prairie View's winning 4 x 100 relay in 45.39. "We only worked on our handoffs the day before the meet. If you have a perfect handoff, no one can touch you. We've been so busy with workouts that we've had no time to work on handoffs. I thought we had a good shot at winning. We had the confidence to win today."

Evans White, Prairie View, 4 x 800 anchor who got a red flag, then the DQ was reversed: "The judge just got a bad angle. I was three strides past the Western Illinois runner. He caught my trail leg with his knee. It flipped both of us."

Kevin Sloan, Kansas State 5th year senior, winner of the long jump at 25-7: "On my great days, I start out slow and build up. My first jump today was 23-8. My fifth was the winner. It's been a long time since I've been so composed at a meet."

Mike Ricks, junior at Kansas, anchor of 4 x 800 relay in 1:48.6: "I knew no one in the field could beat us. I knew that if Korir had to put out that much energy to catch me, it would cost him. I've run against him before and I'm a lot stronger."

David Lee, college 400 meter intermediate hurdles winner with 49.74, junior at Southern Illinois: "I felt pretty good when I started out. Then the wind knocked me off my stride. I'm really scared of running this event - you can hit a hurdle or anyone could beat you. Anyone can have a good day. Anyone who runs this race is strong. This year I've got to run hard in each event - it's the year to do something."

Debra Melrose, 400 meter intermediate hurdles winner, with a new Drake record of 59.02, senior from Prairie View: "I was really scared more than anything. I got lucky and entered only five. I'm through with school and tired of running. It's okay and fund, but enough is enough."

Janice Ohrt, high school girls 800-meter, junior from North Tama, with a new Drake record of 2:15.96. "I'm really surprised. I just about didn't make it. After the last turn I didn't think I had anything left. I guess I did."

James Mallard, 200-meter dash winner with 20.29, from Alabama: "I'm not used to running on the outside lane. I finished up a good race, I felt pretty good today. But I always feel better with good competition. I usually have a pretty strong finish. I really pushed at the last curve. Mainly I tried to just maintain my form."

All's I wanted to do was to get hold of that stick. We really have a lot to prove when we come to a meet like this."

Al Oerter, winner of special discus throw at 200-2: "I came here because I'm tired of some of the intense competition elsewhere. It gets tiring. I could keep throwing every weekend from now until October including 2 European tours. At my age, I guess I'm an oddity and people enjoy seeing oddities. I like track people, they're highly motivated people."

Randy Barrick, anchor in high school boys 4 x 800 meter relay, from Spencer High School: "We did better than we expected. I didn't think we'd be ready for this, but our time is a heck of a lot faster than we thought we'd do. I thought I was going to die because I didn't do enough buildups, but I feel good now."

Brenda Denny, Colorado, 153-8 (Old mark, 150-1, Melanie Heitman, Williamsburg High School, 1979.)

Kipsubai Koskei, ineligible at New Mexico, member of the Kalenjin tribe, Rift Valley, Kenya: "I said I was sorry to Nyambui because he's a better runner than me. But he's hurt and can't run well now. Usually I run an even pace, not like today when the second 5000 was faster. Early in the race I thought Nyambui was going to win. I thought I might win at the 23rd lap. That's enough running for today, and maybe all for this week. For breakfast I just had tea and 2 pieces of toast."

Suleiman Nyambui, UTEP, sophomore, Tanzanian, injured a hamstring during cross country last fall, though still hampered by it. He won the NCAA Indoor Mile-2 Mile in March: "I'm still taking treatment for my hamstring. When I sprint, it hurts."

Chris Leonard, Ankeny High School, winner of the High School Boys 3,200-Meter Run in 9:16.93: "I felt good--I just ran right in the middle of the pack. I was a little slow--I was trying to break away from them at 1 1/2 miles, because I don't have the best kick."

Maureen Houghton, sophomore at Oklahoma, lead off runner in 4 x 800 meter relay, new Drake record with a 8:40.93: "I was surprised I had the lead through the quarter. I didn't want them too close. Considering we never practice our passing, we did pretty well. We thought Wisconsin was going to be tougher. Now maybe the coach will take us out to dinner."

Dan Lavitt, senior at Missouri, winner in 110-meter high hurdles with :13.68: "I sure loved that one. I wasn't quick over the first, third or fourth hurdles. I had no pain in the leg that's been bothering me this season. I'm unbeaten outdoors this year. Maybe I should stop working out because I haven't been working out all week."

Mel Lattany, Georgia, winner 100-meter dash with :10.44: "I let down a little in the middle part of my race, it was a little shakey. I had in my mind that I wanted to run :9.9 handtime. I did about a 3 hour warmup again today. I got here at 1:00 pm, first I was warming up in my motel room at Howard Johnsons, doing stretching. I think James Hines' record will fall, there's a bunch of us up there ready to get it."

Jennie Gorham, freshman at Nebraska, winner in 400-meter dash with :52.86: "One person I was especially concerned with was Gwen Gardner who beat me at the Indoor Nationals. I'm happy with the time because I've not even been close to :54.0 this year. I went on a diet this week and lost five pounds, which makes me run faster. I haven't been able to train much this week because I strained a hamstring."

Steve Scott, Sub Four Track Club, American top ranked miler, winner in 800-meter run with 1:46.79: "I'm pretty sure I had the win. Going into the 2nd lap I thought they'd all run away from me. All of those guys are in excellent shape. I just had one workout oriented toward running a half mile. I don't have as much confidence as running in the mile. The people are right on top of you here."

Todd Harbour, Junior from Baylor, anchor in University Medley Relay, second section, third year to win with 9:38.31: "I felt good--I knew I had enough to run on in, though my legs were a little cramped up. I had hoped to run a little faster, but I do what I can and thank the Lord."

Vince Parrette, KSU senior, winner of Texas-Kansas-Drake triple crown, with today's jump of 54-6: "My foot was worse today than last week, and I don't know why. I guess I was just lucky to jump so well. It hurt on every jump--sort of a sting. I didn't even think of the triple crown as a goal. I just wanted to win everything. Lately, I haven't had a lot of thrills from my triple jumping. The thrill from playing music is a different kind of thrill." Parrette will be leaving on a trip to London one week from tomorrow with his school jazz band and private party band for one week.

Dwayne Evans, anchor on Arizona's 4 x 100 relay team which won in 39.40: "I didn't know if anyone was close to me. I was so far up I didn't have to run any faster. Usually we work a lot on handoffs in practice, but for some reason I didn't get a good one this time."

Joel Light, Junior at Kansas, winner of high jump at 7-0, won by clearing 7-3/4 in a jump-off: "I was really lucky to win today. I was just deadlegged. The adrenalin was really flowing and that's what got me over the bar. I was surprised I didn't have any spring today because I've had phenomenal spring in my workouts recently."

Dean Greensway, in the Special Invitational 400-Meter Dash winning with 46.77: "I have a slight hamstring injury, but I didn't feel it today. I just worked out 2 days for the whole week, every time I bent my leg it would hurt. But there was no problem today. I felt really smooth. I ran the way I wanted, except I didn't run hard enough in the backstretch. This is only my third race all year. My friends were doing well here and that kept me motivated."

Dan Lavitt, anchor in College 4 x 110-Meter Shuttle Hurdle Relay, senior at Missouri, with a new Drake record of 56.5: "We felt confident going into the race, but we knew it would take a good race to beat Southern. There's a saying going around Missouri--We don't run the hurdles, we own them.--"
